



# Phelps County Board Minutes

9:00 A.M. March 13, 2018

The Phelps County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on March 13, 2018 as advertised, with Commissioners Tom Nutt; Rick Streeter; Shelley Brenn; Matt Gregg; Russ Cruise; Theresa Puls and Jim Ostgren present. The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Ostgren. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Jim announced the open meeting law would be in effect and that a copy is posted on the wall. Streeter moved, seconded by Nutt, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Brenn, yes; Streeter, yes; Gregg, yes; Cruise, yes; Puls, yes; Ostgren, yes. Motion carried.

Charlie Brooks, Weed Supt., met with the Board for their approval to hire Nathan Munter as the new Weed Supt., for Phelps County which is a part-time position. Charlie told the Board he will be retiring March 16, 2018. After discussion Gregg moved, seconded by Streeter, to approve the appointment of Nathan Munter as the part-time Weed Supt., for Phelps County. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Brenn, yes; Streeter, yes; Gregg, yes; Cruise, yes; Puls, yes; Ostgren, yes. Motion carried.

Brenn moved, seconded by Cruise, to approve the monthly reports from the clerk, sheriff and clerk of district court. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Brenn, yes; Streeter, yes; Gregg, yes; Cruise, yes; Puls, yes; Ostgren, yes. Motion carried.

Bobby Hamilton, Hwy Supt., met with the Board with his road report. He reviewed the quote he received from Bader Highway for crack sealing approximately 50 miles. After discussion Cruise moved, seconded by Gregg, to accept the quote from Bader's for 3 projects on invoice 288 in the amount of \$10,148. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Brenn, yes; Streeter, yes; Gregg, yes; Cruise, yes; Puls, yes; Ostgren, yes. Motion carried. Gregg moved, seconded by Streeter, to accept the quote from Bader's for 9 projects on invoice 289 in the amount of \$19,272. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Brenn, yes; Streeter, yes; Gregg, yes; Cruise, yes; Puls, yes; Ostgren, yes. Motion carried. The Board approved Bobby advertising for bids on approximately 6 miles of armor coat on April 10, 2018 at 9:15 a.m. Bobby told the Board on March 1, the road dept. hung the weight limit signs for the 2.6 miles of the Atlanta road for 90 days. The weight limitation will be 10 tons on a straight truck, 18 tons on a tractor trailer and 20 tons on a combination truck with a pup trailer. On April 3<sup>rd</sup> they set up the weight limit signs on West 18<sup>th</sup> for approximately 2.3 miles starting at Highway 23 running east for 2.3 miles ending east of Gustin St for 180 days. The weight limitation will be 10 tons on a straight truck, 18 tons on a tractor trailer and 20 tons on a combination truck with a pup trailer.

Matt discussed a meeting he attended.
