The Phelps County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on September 1, 2020 as advertised, with Commissioners Rick Streeter; Barb Malm; Dennis Ostgren; Matt Gregg; Russ Cruise; Theresa Puls; and Tom Nutt present. The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Nutt. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Tom announced the open meeting law would be in effect and that a copy is posted on the wall. Bob Dunaway met with the Board to review the county's budget. He gave preliminary amounts and told the Board is mill levy is an .000135% decrease from last year, the valuation increased by 2,270,575.00.
